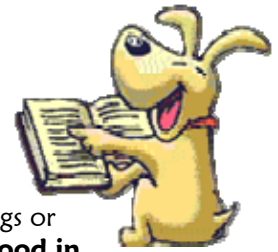


Blue Springs Pet Resort: Camper Checklist

CONFIRM THAT YOUR PET HAS EVERYTHING NEEDED TO STAY AT OUR PET RESORT.



We recommend that you bring your pet's own food to avoid the tummy upset that can occur with sudden diet changes. Please put an amount appropriate for his/her stay in zip lock bags or a plastic container, or bring the amount of cans needed for the stay. **Please do not bring dry food in original bag.**

If your pet is on medications, we will transfer tablets/pills to our dispensers. For liquids or other types of medications, please make sure they are labeled with your last name, pet's name, and directions.

Please allow us to furnish bedding and toys which can be laundered and sanitized in our commercial equipment. If you choose to bring personal items, please limit to 2 per pet. Personal bedding should be no larger than the size of a bath towel. **NO STUFFED OR FOAM BEDDING** that can not be laundered. We do our best to return all personal items, but at times things get misplaced or even – ugggh! – chewed to shreds. You may not get everything back!!

All personal items must be clearly labeled in permanent marker with your last name and your pet's name.

Bring copies of your pet's vaccinations and parasite testing from your veterinarian if the services were not provided by Blue Springs Animal Hospital. We require the following wellness vaccinations and tests for the protection of all campers. If your pet is not current on these services we can update them at the time of their admission to the Resort.

Preventative Health Requirements for Dogs

Health Requirement	Time Frame
Rabies Vaccine (frequency is determined by your city's ordinance)	within the last 1-3 years
Distemper/Parvo Vaccine	within the last 24 months
Leptospirosis Vaccine	within the last 12 months
Upper Respiratory/Bordetella/Kennel Cough Vaccine	within the last 6 months
Heartworm Test*	within the last 12 months
Fecal Parasite Test	within the last 12 months
Flea Preventative (see approved list)	within the last 30 days
Heartworm Preventative (see approved list)	within the last 30 days

*Approved heartworm products include Sentinel, Revolution, Interceptor and Heartguard. If your dog has not been on heartworm preventative, we must do a heartworm test prior to administering the preventative. (Dogs with a current heartworm infection can have a severe reaction to preventative products.)

*Approved Flea products include Sentinel, Program, Frontline, Revolution, Comfortis, Promeris, and Advantage. Flea products from discount stores like Wal-Mart do not provide adequate protection. If your pet has not been treated with an approved product in the last 30 days, we can apply one for you at admission.

Preventative Health Requirements for Cats

Health Requirement	Time Frame
Rabies Vaccine (frequency is determined by your city's ordinance)	within the last 1-3 years
Feline Leukemia Vaccine	within the last 12 months
Distemper/Respiratory Vaccine	within the last 24 months
Fecal Parasite Test	within the last 12 months
Flea Preventative (Frontline, Revolution, or Advantage)*	within the last 30 days
